



■ WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- The winning debate team will receive a prize of:

■ **BACKGROUND**

The Delegation of the European Union to Indonesia (EU) is organising a two-day debate tournament entitled "EU Intervarsity Debate Championship (EU-IDC)" for university students in Indonesia.

The first ever EU-IDC in Indonesia was held in May 2010 as part of the "Europe Day" celebration. A total of 84 debate teams (252 students) from 26 universities across Indonesia registered. Upon registration, each team submitted an essay which was afterwards evaluated by the EU Delegation and resulted in the selection of 20 teams advancing to the tournament stage. The 20 teams presented lively, often heated debates during the tournament which concluded with two teams from Bandung's Parahyangan University competing in the finals

This year's EU-IDC will be held on the occasion of the International Day for Tolerance (16 November).

■ **WHAT IS IT?**

"EU Intervarsity Debate Championship" (EU-IDC) is a debate tournament that aims to encourage university students in Indonesia to:

- increase their awareness and knowledge about the European Union (EU) and its relationship with Indonesia and the wider world
- improve their debating skills.

The EU-IDC is organised and funded by the EU Delegation in Indonesia and implemented by Perfect10 Public Relations.

■ **WHO CAN APPLY?**

- Students:
 - enrolled in an undergraduate programme in universities in Indonesia
 - from any fields of studies
 - able to debate in English
 - Indonesian nationality
- One debate team must comprise 3 debaters (speakers) from the same university.
- A university can have more than one debate team.
- There will be a maximum of 20 debate teams participating (a total of 60 students).

■ **WHEN/WHERE WILL IT BE?**

- The EU-IDC tournament will take place on:
 - Day 1: Thursday, 17 November 2011 at Usmar Ismail Hall, Jakarta
 - Day 2: Friday, 18 November 2011 at Usmar Ismail Hall, Jakarta
 - Prior to the tournament days, there will be an Orientation Session:
 - For debate teams: Tuesday, 1 November 2011, 09:30-11:00 at the EU Delegation in Jakarta
 - For adjudicators: Tuesday, 1 November 2011, 14:00-15:30 at the EU Delegation in Jakarta
- The purpose is to brief debaters and adjudicators about the EU-IDC. Each debate team should be represented at least by one of its members.
